21:22 - He will eventually rob and kill to support his physical indulgences.
4. Why is it a degradation to G-d to hang a criminal's body on the gallows overnight?
21:23 - Because humans are made in G-d's image; and because the Jewish People are G-d's children.
5. What do you do if you find a lost object that costs money to maintain?
22:2 - Sell it and save the money for the owner.
6. Why does the Torah forbid wearing the clothing of the opposite gender?
22:5 - It leads to immorality.
7. Why does the Torah link the mitzvah of sending away the mother-bird with the mitzvah of making a railing on the roof of your house?
22:8 - To teach that one mitzvah leads to another, and to prosperity.

22:12 - Wool *tzitzit* on a linen garment.

24:6 - Utensils used to prepare food.

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Dvar Torah:

In perek kaf aleph, pasuk tet zayin it says, “Vehayah beyom hanchilu et banav et asher yiheyeh lo,” “Then it shall be that on the day the he causes his sons to inherit that which he possesses.”

There are two questions that are commonly asked on this pasuk. The first is that the word “vehayah” according to the Vayikra Rabbah indicates a simcha, a joy, why would an inheritance be something that is considered extra joyful? The second question is that the words “et asher yiheyeh,” “that which he possesses,” seems extra and obvious; of course his children can only inherit what he had.”

There are many parents who pride themselves on giving their children more than they had, or providing them with something better than what they grew up with. Many holocaust survivors discuss the idea of coming to America with very little and being able to build a beautiful family and providing them with a home, an education and many things they lacked. Although this idea is beautiful, it is super critical to not forget our roots and the things we did have. Just as we were raised with Torah and Mitzvos, so to we should be constantly instilling those ideas within our children’s everyday lives. Therefore, it is worthy to rejoice when leaving an inheritance because not only are you providing what you didn’t have but you also are providing the Torah lifestyle that you are currently living.

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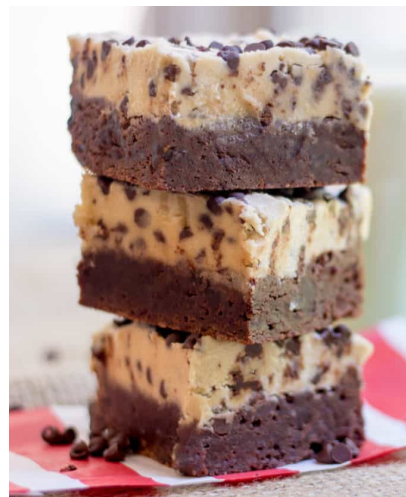
Torah Treat:



In this weeks Parsha, we learn about the laws of Kilayim. Kilayim are a series of prohibitions against intermixing of certain breeds and species. In honor of this idea, we will be making cookie dough brownies, but not mixing them! Wait and see!

What you will need:

1. Cooking spray
 2. 1 box brownie mix, plus ingredients called for on box
 3. 1/2 c. (1 stick) margarine softened
 4. 1/3 c. powdered sugar
- 1 1/2 c. almond flour
- 5.
 6. 1 tsp. pure vanilla extract
 7. 1/2 tsp. kosher salt
 8. 1/2 c. mini chocolate chips



Let's get started:

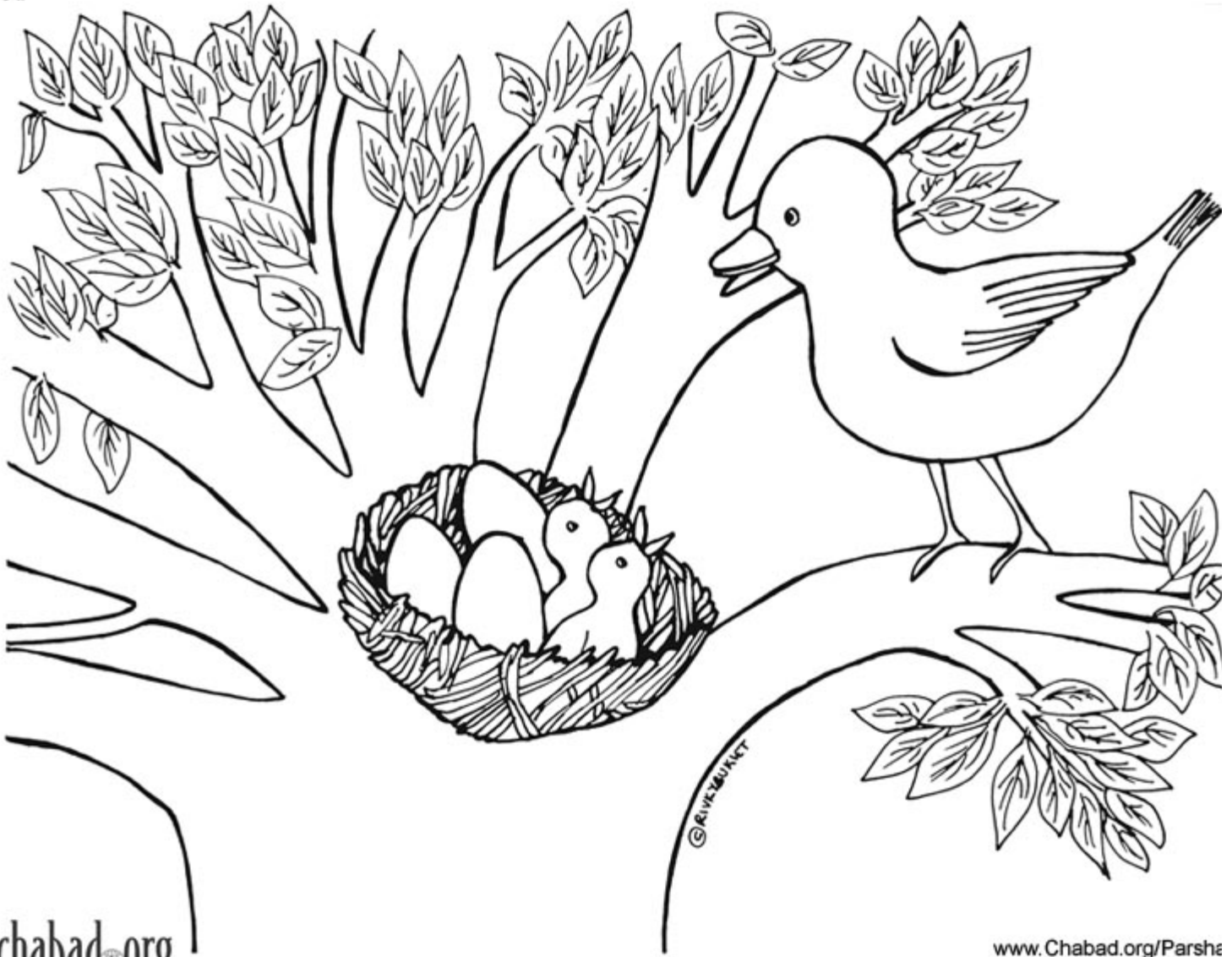
1. Make the cookie dough: In a large bowl, using a hand mixer or a large spoon, cream together margarine and sugar until light and fluffy. Add almond flour, vanilla, and salt, and mix until smooth. Fold in mini chocolate chips.
2. Spray a 9x13 with cookie spray
3. Place in 9x13 pan in the fridge to harden
4. In another bowl, make the brownie mix
5. Take out the 9x13 pan of cookie dough and pour the brownie mix over
6. Bake at 350 degrees Fahrenheit for 20-25 minutes
7. Let cool and Enjoy!
