Even more so, each year we are told to have people at our Seder's who may not have Seder's. The entire concept of Pesach and the Hagaddah is here for us to open up our customs and traditions to welcome others of all backgrounds.

Although this year we are unable to really open up our homes, we can open our hearts spiritually by reaching out to others and embracing the message of Pesach; a united nation.

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Answers for Question Game:


1. Why do we eat Matzah on Passover? **To remind us of the dough that didn't have time to rise as our forefathers were rushed out of Egypt.**
2. Name the Four Sons? **The wise, the wicked, the simple, and the one who doesn't know how to ask.**
3. How many cups of wine do we drink at the Seder? **Four.**
4. What things connected with Seder night are associated with the number four? **Four sons, four cups of wine, four questions.**
5. Why four cups of wine? **To celebrate our freedom.**
6. What is the second plague? **Frogs.**
7. Why do we dip in the Charoset? **The Charoset represents the cement that the Jews used to cement the bricks together in their slavery. Today we dip as a sign of freedom.**
8. What does the shank bone remind us of? **The Passover lamb which our forefathers sacrificed to God when they came out of Egypt.**
9. Can you say all ten plagues in order? **Blood, frogs, vermin, wild beasts, pestilence, boils, hail, locusts, darkness, plague of the firstborn.**
10. Can you say the ten plagues backwards? **Plague of the firstborn, darkness, locusts, hail, boils, pestilence, wild beasts, vermin, frogs, blood.**
11. Who am I? I am the last thing you eat before you bensch, say the blessing after the meal. There are often lots of fights over who hides me and who finds me. Who am I? **The Afikoman.**
12. Who am I? I am one of the key figures in the story of the going out of Egypt. I lost my whole army and half my country in my stubbornness. Who am I? **Pharoah.**



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Make your own Frog Puppet:

What you will need:

1. 1 green paper bag
2. 1 piece of white paper
3. 1 black marker
4. a piece of red paper or thick red ribbon
5. green paper
6. scissors
7. glue

Let's get started:

1. cut out two circles from your white paper
2. color black circles on the inside to look like eyes
3. glue your eyes to the closed side of the bag
4. cut out a thick strand of red paper and fold it over like a fan or cut a piece of red ribbon
5. glue your red paper or ribbon onto the crease of the paper bag
6. take your green paper and draw two arms and hands
7. cut out your arms and hands and glue on the side of the bag
8. decorate!


